1.1.2 Response:

The college is affiliated to Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University and has to adhere to the academic calendar published by the University.

The analysis of above questionnaire is as follow:

Seventy percent teachers are of the view that the syllabus of their respective subjects is good enough and satisfactory. They have firmly said that the internal evaluation system of students of their respective subjects is good and appropriate where as some of the teachers has contrary view. Almost all teachers equivocally say that they can complete the syllabus of their subjects on time. Eighty five percent teachers have agreed to the view that the syllabus of their respective subjects is competent enough for the overall development of students. There are some suggestions which some teachers have registered to the last question in questionnaire. The teacher recommends that the syllabus should also include objective questions to help students in NET/ SET examination. Most of the teachers suggests that to enrich the quality of content of the syllabus, some Skill-oriented activities and certificate courses should be started in respective subjects .

All above suggestions have taken for discussion and forwarded to the University for Further Discussion to bring more transparency in teaching and learning process.

The analysis of the above questionnaire is as follows:

In response to the first question ninety percent employers seem to be satisfied with the educational quality of their employers. Ninety five percent student-employees are capable to satisfy their employers by their education quality. Ninety percent student-employees are good in their work and their education has helped in the office work. At

the same time the participation of student-employee in co-curricular activities is found to be useful in office work. Eighty five percent employees are good in their office work due to their experience in co-curricular activities. Social attitude of the eighty five percent student-employees which was instilled in them by education has helped them in their office-work. Fourty percent employers want changes in syllabus of their respective subjects. Some say that the some Skill-oriented activities and certificate courses should be started in respective subjects. At last, it can be said that the feedback from employers about student employee is positive and satisfactory.
