Khanzode on being selected and appointed the full time and regular principal of college. The Coordinator placed the minutes of previous meeting before the committee and the committee members confirmed the minutes unanimously.
- 2. Dr. S. G. Pund and Prof. Homraj Patelpaik opened the discussion on outcomes of online teaching as the IQAC Coordinator Dr. Rajput had read the second point on agenda. The online mode of teaching for students was introduced to cope with an unprecedented emergency situation created by the spread of Corona virus pandemic and lockdown. Dr. S. G.
