'Career Katta' is an initiative being run jointly by the Maharashtra State Higher and Technical Education Department and Maharashtra Information Technology Support Center. Under this initiative, this information booklet has been created with the aim of making all the stakeholders aware of all the initiatives being implemented in accordance with the new National Education Policy for students studying in colleges in the state.

Out of 100 proposed Centers of Excellence in the state, 60 have been operationalized, with the remaining 40 set to be operational in 2025-2026. 50 police pre-recruitment training centers have also been operationalized well. Under the Career Katta initiative, students are provided expert guidance through 10 State Resource Centers. Model Skill Development schemes are being implemented to reach students through various Central Government schemes. The Agriculture Development Trust, Baramati is working to create over 1500 entrepreneurs through special training for youth interested in agricultural sectors. The 'Madhur Kranti' initiative aims to provide supplementary practical training for beekeeping at the university level, with over a hundred colleges offering scientifically based four-wheeler training and 'Business vans' for small businesses. International organizations like 'Garje Marathi Global' are facilitating international business and job opportunities for students. Expert mentors for startups are also available on the Career Katta platform. District-level Career Parliament Planning Committees have been formed across the state, with district coordinators and principal promoters working to implement the initiative aims to positively impact the lives of over 12 lakh students in the next five years.

The program offers a comprehensive educational program for first-year graduation students, including two 30-hour activities and a credit course on various government, state, and public sector companies. The program includes a Competitive Examination Foundation Course (250 hours) for first-year undergraduate students, focusing on syllabus preparation for competitive exams. The course also covers 120-hour preparation for banking exams and 120-hour written tests for police recruitment training. For students preparing for competitive exams through UPSC and MPSC, advanced courses are provided. A practice test is conducted once a month for all types of competitive examinations.

Expert coaches are provided online, with 52 former Chartered Officers providing one-on-one guidance per week. Students are also informed about government employee recruitment advertisements and can prepare their documents online. Interviews with district level officers and retired officers are also conducted. Field visits are organized to raise awareness about competitive exams and create awareness among children. The program aims to provide comprehensive guidance for students preparing for competitive exams.

The Maharashtra State Higher and Technical Education Department and Maharashtra Information Technology Support Centre have jointly organized an initiative to increase college youth's participation in industry and business. The program aims to help students develop necessary skills and knowledge to start a business. The initiative is being implemented across Maharashtra, with guidance provided by representatives from various banks, successful entrepreneurs, and administrative officials. The initiative aims to create entrepreneurship in the country by providing planning, effective design, and entrepreneurial values. It also aims to meet entrepreneurs, banking officers, business advisors, and government schemes. Courses in 52 entrepreneurs and related subjects will be available annually.

• Skill Training Activities (कौशल्य प्रशिक्षण उपक्रम)

The Agriculture Development Trust Baramati is collaborating with Career Katta to train students in rural areas in agriculture. The initiative aims to equip them with new technologies, particularly in the agriculture sector, to increase their income and provide information about employment opportunities. The initiative includes training in agriculture drone repair, maintenance, operating skills, and licenses, as well as e-commerce. The first batch of 100 students completed their training, and over 1,400 students will be trained in the coming years. The initiative also focuses on CSR (CSR) to help students become self-reliant and provide jobs through their own businesses. The Krishi Vigyan Kendra and Atal Incubation Centre at Shardabai Pawar Women's Arts Commerce and Science College are instrumental in training farmers and students in Maharashtra. The goal is to create an agricultural entrepreneur mindset, fostering a more selfreliant and entrepreneurial mindset among students.

• फॅकल्टी डेव्हलपमेंट प्रोग्राम (FDP)

The Faculty Development Program (FDP) aims to enhance teaching methods and adopt new technologies to improve student outcomes. It is crucial for achieving students' full potential in the current era. Under the Career Kata initiative, faculty benefit from the FDP, making them more competent and promoting promotions and salary increases. FDPs are conducted in collaboration with the UGC-Malaviya Mission Teacher Training Centre.

The Maharashtra State Higher and Technical Education Department and the Maharashtra Information Technology Assistance Centre have been implementing 'Career Katta' for several years, focusing on the development of students. The initiative began with a proposal to address the topic of 'Future of the Country' through voice workshops for teachers. The Minister of Higher and Technical Education, Uday Samant, emphasized the need for such workshops and promised to provide all possible help. The initiative has been implemented in 28 districts of Maharashtra, with 30 workshops held in total. The aim is to reach every teacher in the state, benefiting both teachers and students. Feedback from faculty members who have benefited from these workshops is encouraging. The Maharashtra State High Court, Department of Technical Education, and the Maharashtra Information Technology Assistance Centre have extended their support in this work.

The colleges will be responsible for registering students and paying the required fees.

Maharashtra State Higher and Technical Education Department and Maharashtra Information Technology Assistance Centre to give the right direction to the career of the youth under the ongoing Career Katta initiative. The objective is to set up a Centre of Excellence in selected colleges in the state. The important role behind this is that many children are preparing for competitive exams in the states.
